## Watermelon Fruit Salad. Never the Same Thing Twice!

### **Have fun when deciding how to make the watermelon fruit salad for your carved basket . . .**

Pick other fruit to include based on color – blueberries, watermelon and honeydew melon create a great red, white and blue patriotic look.

Cut fruit with unique cutters. Use a French-fry crinkle cutter to make wavy shapes like in the submarine carving. Cookie cutters in different shapes, including heart, star or leaf shapes, create a professional look.

Add small, bright-colored fruit candies to the salad for a kid's party. Gummy fish and sharks make a beach scene carving even more fun.

Pick fun-shaped fruit for your salad – carambola (star fruit) makes a star design and strawberries make a heart shape when sliced.

For a fast fruit salad cut quick chunks. For a fancier look melon balls are always a favorite.



## Quick Watermelon Chunks Come Straight from the Rind!

Cutting watermelon into convenient chunks is fast and easy. Eat at home or toss in a "to-go" container to take the office, the beach or soccer practice. Just cut a grid pattern on the surface of the fruit. Cubes will tumble out, ready to eat. See the CD-ROM for directions.
