Directions for 8 1/2" x 11" Mobile

Supplies

Mobile component pages (download from Web site)

Scissors

Pencil or pen

Glue stick

Elastic string (found in craft stores)

- 1. Download the 2 pages of mobile components and print. (If possible, use card stock for best results.)
- 2. Cut out each mobile component from both pages.
- 3. Using a glue stick, glue A1 to the back of A2, B1 to B2, and so on.
- 4. Punch out holes on each component with a pen or pencil tip.
- 5. Cut a 2 3/4" piece of elastic string and connect A to B, tying knots in each hole.
- 6. Attach B to D with a 3 3/4" piece of string.
- 7. Attach B to C with a 2 ¾" piece of elastic string.
- 8. Attach B to E with a 2 3/4" piece of elastic string.
- 9. Attach D to F with a 2 3/4" piece of elastic string.
- 10. Attach a piece of elastic string to the top of A and hang.
