

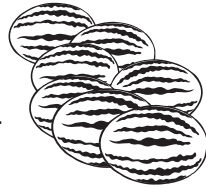
# Watermelon - A Slice of Fun!

Who planted the least? \_\_\_\_\_

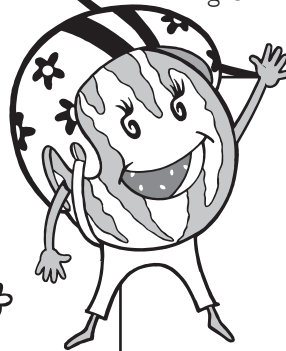


## Fun Facts!
