Watermelon Day

Bulletin Board

Directions

Supplies

- Blue bulletin board art paper
- Transparent tape
- Staple gun or stapler
- Letters
- Speech bubbles (Before printing, choose bubbles you would like to feature on board. Use white cardstock for sturdier bubbles.)
- Watermelon slice, whole watermelon and leaves templates
- Scissors
- Red, green and black construction paper
- Glue stick or spray adhesive
- White cardstock, optional
- Green and black markers
- Double-sided tape
- School clear glue

Directions

- 1. Tape or staple bulletin board art paper to your board.
- 2. Print and cut out letters. (Optional—Use glue stick or spray adhesive to mount letters to a red background. Then cut out, leaving a small border around letters.)
- 3. Print and cut out speech bubbles.
- 4. Print and cut out watermelon slice, whole watermelon and leaves templates. Trace onto red and green construction paper. Draw seeds and stripes on watermelon and veins on leaves. Glue the watermelon slice flesh and rind together. (Optional—Keep any scrap paper to use in Step 5.)
- 5. Tape letters, speech bubbles, watermelons, slices and leaves to the bulletin board. (Optional—Separately, tape watermelons and slices back to back with double-sided tape, leaving one side open. Stuff with scrap paper from Step 4, tape closed and staple or tape to bulletin board. Twist green construction paper into vines and tape or staple to board around watermelons and leaves.)



















Watermelon Day Bulletin Board Whole Watermelon

Bulletin Board Slice (Rind)


